2017 Washington Wing Flight Academy Packing / Check List

- Use this list as a guide. You may bring other items, such as reading material as long as the items are not on the PROHIBITED list.
- All personal items MUST be marked with your last name.
 - o Uniform and under shirts should be marked on the shirttail
 - o Underpants should be marked on the waistband
 - o Uniform pants should be marked on the product label
- **You will not be able to purchase uniform items at the Academy**
- Cadets and Seniors will be issued approved Academy T-shirts to be worn as the uniform of the day.
- The Class B uniform for cadets and equivalent for Seniors will be worn for graduation
- There is a limited opportunity to wash clothing at the Academy.
- The quantities noted below are suggested minimums. Remember to bring enough equipment for a stay of 13 days.

Uniform Items (per latest revision of CAPR 39-1)

- 1 dress blue, short sleeve shirt with all required patches, grade insignia and name plate
- 1 dress blue trousers
- 1 dress blue cover
- 1 pair black socks
- 1 pair black shoes to wear with dress blues
- 1 white T-shirt
- 6 pair plain white socks
- 1 pair plain athletic, closed toe shoes, to wear with flight line uniform of the day
- 3 pair khaki shorts or long pants (Academy approved T-shirt will be issued)
- Black belt or bdu belt
- Air Force style sunglasses

Personal Clothing

- 10 sets underwear
- 3 bras for females
- Casual civilian clothing for free time
- Shower shoes (to be worn only to, from, and in the shower)
- 1 Grey hooded sweatshirt recommended for cool mornings
- 1 Conservative swimming suit

Personal Items – Mandatory Documents

- Current CAP ID card
- FAA Medical for Power Students
- Student Pilot Certificate for Power and Glider Students
- Proof of citizenship document (Passport or Birth Certificate)
- Current 101 card
- Photo ID

Personal Items – Mandatory Equipment

- Sleeping bag or bed linen
- Pillow – if desired
- Tooth brush, tooth paste, mouth wash
- Bath soap with container
- Comb and/or brush, shampoo
- Razor and shaving cream or electric razor
- Wash cloth and bath towel
- Feminine hygiene products for females
- Sunscreen (SPF 45 recommended)
- Lip balm and chap stick
- Foot powder
- Laundry bag
- Flashlight with at least two sets of batteries
- 3 ball point pens
- Shoeshine kit
- Sewing kit
- Note pad, pocket size
- Camelback or canteen with belt for hydration

Personal Items – Optional

- Camera
- Foot powder
- Hair spray/gel
- Neck buddy cooling device

PROHIBITED ITEMS

- **CELL PHONES** – *ON ARRIVAL SHOULD BE TURNED IN TO REGISTRAR – MAY BE USED DURING OFF TIME FOR LIMITED CALLS HOME*
