2017 Washington Wing Flight Academy RULES OF CONDUCT

1. Follow the chain of command at all times
2. No hazing (sexual or verbal) or horseplay will be permitted. Reference CAPR 52-10 "Hazing is defined as any conduct whereby someone causes another to suffer or to be exposed to any activity that is cruel, abusive, humiliating, oppressive, demeaning, or harmful. "
3. Romantic relationships detract from the professional environment, distract from the serious business at hand and have no place at the Academy. Public displays of affection, such as hand-holding, embracing, walking arm-in-arm, etc. are inappropriate.
4. The following items are **PROHIBITED** and **MUST NOT** be brought to the Academy by students.
 - a. Alcohol, tobacco, or non-prescribed controlled substances.
 - b. Knives
 - c. Matches, lighters, fire starters, fireworks
 - d. Electronic devices i.e.: boom boxes, radios, cd players, iPods, iPads, computers, games or other electronic devices.
 - e. Questionable reading material including sexually explicit text and/or photographs, racial or political offensive materials.
 - f. Food of any kind (candy, chips, etc.)
 - g. Firearms, air guns, paint guns or any devices that could be used as weapons.
5. ***Cell phones must be turned in at check in but may be made available during free time in the evening as required for calls home.***
6. Personnel will remain at their assigned posts until relieved.
7. Personnel will report to their duty assignment PROMPTLY.
8. Cadets will wear the prescribed CAP uniform of the day while on duty.
9. Cadets will remain in the building and in their bunks after "lights out" except for necessary trips to rest rooms. ***NOTE: Being outside the building after lights out will be grounds for automatic dismissal.***
10. Male cadets are not allowed in female quarters and vice versa. ***NOTE: Violation of this policy will be grounds for automatic dismissal.***
10. Personnel will adhere to proper standards of personal hygiene (daily showers).
11. Conduct during the Flight Academy will be professional and present a positive image of CAP.
12. Sign In and Sign Out procedures for entering and leaving the CAP compound must be followed.
13. No riding on or in motorized or non-motorized vehicles or aircraft at any time except for official CAP vehicles or aircraft operated by CAP Senior members.
14. No gambling.
15. ***Any Cadet who brings a personal vehicle to the Academy MUST turn in their vehicle keys to the registrar.***



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VIOLATION OF ANY OF THE RULES WILL BE DEALT WITH PROMPTLY AND MAY RESULT IN DISMISSAL FROM THE ACADEMY WITH POSSIBLE FORFEITURE OF SOME OR ALL FEES PAID.

Furthermore I understand that violation of the rules above may result in dismissal from the Academy with possible forfeiture of some or all fees paid.
